The HALLE FÜR KUNST Steiermark is an innovative exhibition venue devoted to the presentation of contemporary and modern art in international contexts, while also including local and regional art production in its program. These different perspectives mean that HALLE FÜR KUNST Steiermark is a communicative museum that does not see international art as somewhere beyond the local context. In differing formats including solo and themed group exhibitions, performances, and residencies, the curatorial team wishes to react directly to the manifold means of contemporary artistic production and to be a venue open to resonance from relevant discourse. The museum's late modernist 1952 architecture and the surrounding park create a very special setting. This physical space is enhanced by the museum website, which is a platform reflecting and disseminating all the different themes and forms of artistic production that the museum explores.

The exhibitions are free to visit.

ACCESSIBILITY

Parking

- Short-stay parking zone in Erzherzog Johann Allee, approx. 70 - 200 metres away
- The parking zone on Burgring directly in front of the HALLE FÜR KUNST Steiermark is unfortunately reserved for coaches during the day
- 2 marked disabled parking spaces at Burgring 6 and 8 (on the other side of the park!), 300 m to the Halle für Kunst

ENTRANCE

There are 6 steps to the **main entrance**, which is therefore not barrier-free.

Steps:

- 16 cm high (1st step 17 cm), 31 cm deep, at least 120 cm wide
- Handrail flat, **not easy to grasp**

The **barrier-free side entrance** is easy to find and easily accessible (parallel to the Burgring).

Ramp

- 7% gradient (ÖNorm max. 6%)
- Movement area of 150 x 150 cm guaranteed at the start and end of the ramp
- Non-slip floor (Asphalt)
- Handrail available on one side (in 2 different heights: 75 cm and 100 cm)
- Wheel deflector available

Vestibule

- Automatic hinged door made of glass, door clearance 100 cm
- opens prematurely, closes with a time delay
- Door threshold 1 cm, double threshold
- interior door handle: Panic bar
- 2nd door: automatic hinged door, door size 110 cm
- opens prematurely, closes with a time delay

INTERIOR AREA

- Information desk: counter at a **height of 120 cm** (standard max. 85 cm), **no under-desk wheelchair access**, glare-free lighting
- All exhibition rooms are easy to roll on (epoxy resin-coated concrete floor, no carpets)

Ground floor

- a small part of the exhibition area (behind the front wall) is at a 28 cm higher level. This is bridged by a **fixed ramp**.
- Ramp: 3 m long, 137 cm wide, **9.5% gradient** (standard max. 6%), not straight
- Non-slip surface (epoxy resin coating), wheel deflectors available, **no handrail**

Basement (accessible via a lifting platform)

- The doors to the showroom below are always open.
- Door **threshold of 3 cm** is overcome via a small, mobile ramp with a depth of 10 cm
- Cloakroom lockers: mostly at an easily accessible height; **access very narrow!**

LIFTING PLATFORM

(to the exhibition area, WC and lockers in the basement)

- Located right next to the barrier-free entrance
- Sufficient space before entering and exiting
- Switch to call the lift must be held down
- Door opens automatically, door clearance 90 cm
- Cabin 140 x 100 cm in size, operating elements at a height of between 90 - 110 cm
- Control element must be held down until the door opens automatically on arrival
- Controls not in Braille
- Short handrail available



Lifting platform

BARRIER-FREE WC (in the basement)


- Accessible with lifting platform
- Separately arranged WC, unisex
- Hinged door with lever handle, door clearance 90 cm
- Room dimensions 215 x 160 cm, turning circle of 150 x 150 cm guaranteed
- WC can be approached from the right, 96 cm space on this side for approaching
- WC height: **42 cm** (standard 46 - 48 cm)
- Folding support handle at a height of 76 cm, angled handle also at a height of 76 cm
- Flush and paper can be reached from the WC while seated
- Washbasin: top edge 87 cm, wheelchair accessible height 79 cm, 50 cm deep
- Mirror: lower edge at **114 cm height** (standard max. 95 cm)
- Emergency call bell available (also accessible from the floor at a maximum height of 35 cm)
